Unleash your creativity with the world's best manipulatives! Engage in problem-solving, explore patterns and collaborate with others.

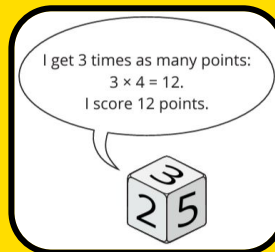
