


Strategic Plan **2020-2024**

ACTIONS

Academic Excellence

ACTIONS

- · Continue commitment of one-to-one devices for every student and staff member.
- · Commitment to developing students personal and academic success and staff knowledge and skills.
- · Implement programs and supports that address the learning needs of all students and families.

Experiential Learning

ACTIONS

- · Inquiry- based student led investigations STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, math).
- Explicit connections between curricular areas and careers/trades/technology and land based activities.
- · Enhance community partnerships and parent engagement.

ACTIONS

· Student pathway exploration and maintenance of their individualized digital pathways portfolio.

Mental Health, Well Being and Inclusive Education

ACTIONS

- Use of the following resources will support student/staff Mental Health and Well-being (e.g Third Path, Fourth R, Second Step, Zones of Regulation, etc.)
- · Student programming will continue to be strength-based, Inquiry-based and differentiated.
- · Safe, healthy, inclusive learning environments will be further developed in all schools.
- · Students well being data collected every two years through a School Climate Survey.



Relationships/Partnerships

ACTIONS

- · Ongoing conversations to map a good path forward.
- Continue to foster and enhance relationships/ partnership between the senior team, schools and neighbouring Indigenous communities and organizations.
- Create more welcoming spaces in and outside of our schools.

Truth and Reconciliation

ACTIONS

- Purposeful and sustained integration of Indigenous history and culture - perspectives and/or language across the curriculum in order to support #62 and #63 Calls to Action.
- · Supporting Native Language programming.
- · School staff with communities/partners to plan celebrations of Indigenous culture that reflect their region.

Cultural Awareness & Appreciation

ACTIONS

- Bring Knowledge Keepers, Elders, and/or Senators in to develop stronger cultural understanding.
- · Board-wide Indigenous Professional Development Day.
- · Land acknowledgments at all meetings.
- · Continued training for Senior Team and Principals.
- Attendance by Senior Team, Indigenous Education Lead and school staff at events or professional learning offered by neighbouring First Nations Communities (Pow Wows, professional learning days, etc.)

ACTIONS

- Hiring of new Network Analyst to assist with monitoring Network intrusion attempts.
- · Ensure Anti Malware and Antivirus is up to industry standards.
- To educate other Technicians through training and train end users, staff and stakeholders about certain types of attempts and what to look for.

Enhance Digital Learning

ACTIONS

 Setup and install the audio and video cameras and microphones in each classroom.

New Student Information System

ACTIONS

· Board moving to a modern program to store student information that responds to the needs of all stakeholders.

ACTIONS

ACTIONS

ACTIONS

- · Examine, compare and document HR resources and processes.
- Data collection on HR Processes throughout the board by school.
- · Determine consistencies and inconsistencies.
- · Provide training to principals.

HR Supply Staffing Plan

ACTIONS

- · Examine and assess existing approach to hiring staff to determine needs.
- · Collect data internally and externally (ex: delivery, reporting, oversight, forecasting, qualified supply staff).
- Develop new approaches as part of annual strategic plan.
- · Expand qualified applicant demographic.



Physical Environment

ACTIONS

- Modernization of all school buildings and facilities and ensuring we are maximizing energy efficiency.
- · Update and enhancement of the interior and exterior of all buildings.
- · Ensure all cleaning products are environmentally safe and effective.
- · Continuing the reduction of utility costs.

Student Spaces

ACTIONS

- · Improve facilities and classroom learning environments eg. new lighting, ventilation.
- New furniture and technology in all classrooms to modernize and support flexible seating, creativity and 21st Century Learning.
- Development of outdoor spaces to ensure focus on learning and/or play environments.

Facility Safety

ACTIONS

- · Ensure all safety issues brought forward are completed in a timely manner.
- · Ensuring all facilities and spaces are accessible to all.



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
